The GF210 Biomass Boiler is RHI compliant when fuelled with logs, waste wood and cereal crop straw. The quarterly government RHI payments can mean the payback on a log dryer installation could be just 2-5 years.

GlenFarrow makes the RHI application process as easy as possible for all our customers. We put together all the paperwork, supporting images and commissioning reports needed and then submit everything to Ofgem on our customers' behalf.

This model offers increased peak output capacity along with enhanced flexibility in batch-fed fuelling due to the larger chamber size.

Cereal crop straw can now be used as a fuel in both our GF210 and GF295 Biomass Boilers, in both square and round bales.
